[note that Trōiāē is really Trōjāē, “i” is not a vowel]

Ītālī|ām fā|tō prōfū|gūs Lā|vīnāquě | vēnīt

[note that book has printed “Lavinaque” in a metrically impossible form, Laviniaque; ignore the second “i”]

lītōrā, | mūltum ī|le ēt tēr|rīs iāc|tātūs ēt | āltō

[note that iactatus is really jactatus, “i” is not a vowel]

vī sūpē|rūm sā|vāe mēmō|rēm lū|nōnīs ūb | īrām,

[note that Iunonis is really Junonis, “i” is not a vowel]

mūltā quo|qūe ēt bēl|lō pās|sūs, dūm | cōndērēt |  
ūrbēm (5)

īnfēr|rētquě dē|ōs Lātī|ō, gēnūs | ūndē Lā|tīnūm

Ālbā|nīquě pāt|rēs āt|qūe āltāē | mōēnā | Rōmāē.

[note that ūē = œ, a diphthong or one long syllable, although consisting of two vowels]
